- HHW/E-Waste must be **transported securely in the trunk** of your vehicle and separated from personal belongings
- You'll be asked to **remain in your vehicle at all times** during the unloading process

A maximum of 15 gallons or 125 pounds of hazardous waste can be transported per trip.

What is HHW? Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) is any product labeled toxic, poisonous, corrosive, flammable, combustible or irritant. **NOTE:** All waste collection services are suspended during rainy weather.

Residential HHW/E-Waste Only This service is for only for residential HHW and Electronic Waste.
